Paragraph (c) is added to subsection (2) of 10 section 316.006, Florida Statutes, to read: 11 12 316.006 Jurisdiction.--Jurisdiction to control traffic is vested as follows: 13 (2) MUNICIPALITIES.--14 15 (c) Municipalities shall have jurisdiction and authority to regulate and restrict commercial vehicle traffic 16 17 over all streets and highways located within their boundaries by granting permits, franchises, and licenses or by otherwise 18 19 exercising such authority. The purpose of this paragraph is to 20 reinforce the long-standing policy of this state. 21 22 This subsection shall not limit those counties which have the charter powers to provide and regulate arterial, toll, and 23 other roads, bridges, tunnels, and related facilities from the 24 25 proper exercise of those powers by the placement and maintenance of traffic control devices which conform to the 26 manual and specifications of the Department of Transportation 27 28 on streets and highways located within municipal boundaries. 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 30 law. 31
