23	students in the purchase of used instructional materials. This
24	program is limited to the counties of Hernando, Pasco, and
25	Polk. Charter schools in those school districts may also
26	participate in the pilot program. When a secondhand book
27	dealer or other third-party book vendor provides used adopted
28	instructional materials to a school district, the dealer or
29	vendor must certify the availability of the used instructional
30	materials, provide the International Standard Book Number of
31	each of the used instructional materials, and certify that

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1	such materials are not samples or first printings, are the
2	most currently adopted, Florida-specific instructional
3	materials, and conform to the Sunshine State Standards. The
4	state is not responsible for financial loss caused by the

7	Research and Improvement shall submit to the President of the
8	Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives for
9	consideration during the 2005 Regular Session a report of the
10	cost savings to school districts based on results of the pilot
11	program. This section is repealed July 1, 2007.
12	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004.
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
