The moneys in this fund are hereby continually appropriated for the purposes of land acquisition, management, 19 maintenance, capital improvements of land titled to the 20 districts, payments in lieu of taxes, debt service on bonds 21 22 issued prior to July 1, 1999, debt service on bonds issued on 23 or after July 1, 1999, which are issued to refund bonds issued 24 before July 1, 1999, preacquisition costs associated with land purchases, and the department's costs of administration of the 2.5 fund.
