Payment 18 19 on behalf of these Medicaid eligible persons is subject to the 20 availability of moneys and any limitations established by the 21 General Appropriations Act or chapter 216. 22 (11) Subject to specific federal authorization, a 23 person who, but for earnings in excess of the limit established under s. 1905(q)(2)(B) of the Social Security Act, 24 25 would be considered for receiving supplemental security 26 income; who is at least 16 but less than 65 years of age; and 27 whose assets, resources, and earned and unearned income do not 28 exceed 250 percent of the most current federal poverty level. 29 Such persons may be eligible for Medicaid services as part of 30 a Medicaid buy-in established under s. 409.914(2) specifically designed to accommodate those persons made eligible for such a 31 1
