Section 1003.33, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 13 1003.33 Report cards; end-of-the-year status.--14 (1) Each district school board shall establish and 15 publish policies requiring the content and regular issuance of 16 17 student report cards for all elementary school, middle school, and high school students. These report cards must clearly 18 19 depict and separately grade each of the following: 20 (a) The student's academic performance in each class or course, which in grades 1 through 12 must be based upon 21 22 examinations as well as written papers, class participation, and other academic performance criteria, and must include the 23 student's performance or nonperformance at his or her grade 24 25 level. (b) The student's conduct and behavior. 26 27 (c) The student's attendance, including absences and 28 tardiness. 29 30 The district school board may not allow schools to use a

1 or a student's grade for attendance under paragraph (c) in 2 calculating the student's grade for academic performance under 3 paragraph (a). (2) A student's final report card for a school year 4 5 shall contain a statement indicating end-of-the-year status 6 regarding performance or nonperformance at grade level, 7 acceptable or unacceptable behavior and attendance, and 8 promotion or nonpromotion. 9 10 District school boards shall not allow schools to exempt 11 students from academic performance requirements based on practices or policies designed to encourage student 12 13 attendance. A student's attendance record may not be used in 14 whole or in part to provide an exemption from any academic 15 performance requirement. 16 Section 2.
