Section 1. Florida Building Commission review of construction practices and inspections. --

16 (1) LEGISLATIVE FINDINGS AND INTENT. -- The Legislature 17 finds that due to the rapidly increasing rate of construction which has occurred in the first few years of the 21st century, 18 19 the possibility exists for an increase in the prevalence of 20 construction flaws and for a decrease in the quality of building and home inspections. The intent of the Legislature 21 22 is that the review initiated under this act will produce findings that will increase the quality of construction and 23 optimize the effectiveness of building and home inspections, 24 25 while providing protection for builders, inspectors, and 26 consumers.

(2) REVIEW PROCEDURES. -- Beginning July 1, 2004, the Florida Building Commission shall conduct a review of current construction practices in this state for the purpose of formulating recommendations concerning how to improve the quality of construction in the state and how to maximize the

effectiveness of the building inspections and home inspections associated with such construction. The commission shall conduct or contract for research that supports this purpose and shall conduct hearings and any other activities that the commission considers essential in fulfilling this purpose. REPORT. -- By January 15, 2005, the Florida Building Commission shall write a report of its findings under this section and shall submit copies of the report to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The report must include any recommendations for proposed legislation that the commission considers appropriate and necessary. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004. SENATE SUMMARY Requires the Florida Building Commission to review construction practices and building and home inspections in this state and to formulate recommendations concerning how to improve construction quality and maximize the effectiveness of building and home inspections. Requires the commission to report to the Governor and to legislative leaders by a specified date and to include in the report appropriate recommendations for legislation.
