An employee or agent of an insurer, before accepting an application for private passenger motor vehicle 11 12 insurance, must: (1) Give the applicant a written disclosure statement 13 14 that; (a) Describes in plain language the types and amounts 15 16 of coverages that are available in this state, including 17 bodily injury liability, personal injury protection, property damage liability, medical payments, uninsured and underinsured 18 19 motorist, collision, and comprehensive coverages; and 20 (b) States which types and amounts of coverage are 21 provided in the proposed policy; 22 (2) Explain such coverages to the applicant and answer 23 any questions from the applicant; (3) Have the applicant initial the description of each 24 coverage and sign the disclosure statement acknowledging that 25 the employee or agent explained the coverages and that the 26 27 applicant understands them; and 28 (4) Provide a copy of the signed disclosure statement 29 to the applicant. 30 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004. 31 1
