(b) Any legal resident of this state who is serving 1 2 under honorable conditions on active duty as a member of the 3 United States Armed Forces, the Florida National Guard, or the 4 United States Reserve Forces and has rendered exceptional 5 meritorious service to the citizens of this state while on 6 active duty; or 7 (c) Any legal resident of this state who has been 8 honorably discharged from active duty as a member of the 9 United States Armed Forces, the Florida National Guard, or the United States Reserve Forces and, while on active duty, 10 rendered exceptional meritorious service to the citizens of 11 this state. 12 13 14 As used in this subsection, the term "exceptional meritorious 15 service" means acts of bravery above and beyond the level of duty normally required by that person's respective military or 16 17 civilian position.
