Section 1. Subsection (12) is added to section 290.0065, Florida Statutes, to read:

290.0065 State designation of enterprise zones.--

(12) Before November 30, 2004, any county as defined in s. 125.011 may apply to the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development to change the boundaries of an existing enterprise zone for the purpose of replacing an area of not more than 75 acres within the enterprise zone as of January 1, 2004, with an area of the same number of acres outside the enterprise zone as of January 1, 2004. The replacement area must be contiguous to the existing enterprise zone and must be a part of a revitalization area that has been targeted for assistance by the county. The replacement area also must be contiguous to a zoo and the county must have previously completed a master plan for development of the area. The Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development shall approve the amendment effective January 1, 2005, if the enterprise zone remains consistent with the criteria and conditions imposed by s. 290.0055 upon the establishment of enterprise zones, including the requirement

HB 1437 2004 that the area suffer from pervasive poverty, unemployment, and 30 31 general distress. 32 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004.
