16-1163-04 See HR 9001 1 Senate Resolution No. \_\_\_\_ 2 A resolution recognizing April 14, 2004, as 3 Aviation Day in Florida. 4 5 WHEREAS, the aviation industry is one of the 6 cornerstones of Florida's economy, with 19 commercial service 7 airports and 111 general aviation airports that are open to the public and more than 550 private airports, and 8 9 WHEREAS, Florida's airports provide nearly \$90 billion 10 annually in economic activity, and its aviation industry supports over one million jobs that generate more than \$26 11 12 billion in annual payroll, and WHEREAS, Florida has the largest flight training 13 14 industry in the world, and WHEREAS, Florida's commercial service airports provide 15 nonstop scheduled service to 160 domestic and international 16 17 destinations, serve 110 million passengers annually, handle 6 percent of the nation's air cargo, and carry in excess of 50 18 19 percent of the visitors that come to the state each year, and 20 WHEREAS, each year, Florida's general aviation aircraft 21 bring 9 million visitors to the state, and its general 22 aviation airports house 14,000 aircraft, comprising 6 percent of the nation's general aviation fleet, and accommodate 7 23 24 million takeoffs and landings yearly, ranking Florida second 25 in the nation in this area, NOW, THEREFORE, 26 27 Be It Resolved by the Senate of the State of Florida: 28 That the Florida Senate acknowledges the outstanding 29 30 contributions made by the more than one million employees of 31 1
