Section 403.0879, Florida Statutes, is 15 16 created to read: 17 403.0879 Reports on aquifer storage and recovery wells and other underground injection control programs. -- The 18 19 department shall publish on its public website, no later than 20 60 days following the end of the 6th and 12th month of each 21 calendar year, a report containing cumulative statistics on 22 the usage of Florida's aquifers for the state's aquifer 23 storage and recovery wells and other underground injection 24 control programs. Such report must include, at a minimum: 25 (1) The number of wells permitted, by type. (2) The permit numbers for all permitted wells, the 26 27 applicant or operator, the date of application, and the date 28 of issuance for each permit. 29 (3) The injection zone, depth, and permitted flow rate 30 for each permitted well. 31

1	(4) The location, including county, of each well and
2	statistics attesting to the verified recovery rate in the case
3	of aquifer storage and recovery wells.
4	(5) The classification of treatment such water
5	received prior to injection, the source of such injected
6	water, the amount of injected water, and the amount of water
7	recovered during each operational cycle.
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9	The report required under this section must include
10	information on all injection wells, as defined in rule
11	62-528.200(37), Florida Administrative Code, which are used to
12	inject any amount of water. Included in this definition are
13	test injection wells, as defined in rule 62-528.200(58),
14	Florida Administrative Code, which are used to inject any
15	amount of water.
16	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004.
