In order to facilitate checking information in a consumer credit report and disputing any inaccurate 13 information, as permitted by the federal Fair Credit Reporting 14 Act, each consumer credit reporting agency that compiles and 15 maintains files on consumers' credit on a nationwide basis 16 17 shall furnish one complete consumer credit report relating to the consumer's credit at no charge to any consumer in this 18 19 state who requests a consumer credit report. The agency shall furnish the credit report once each calendar year after the 20 21 consumer provides appropriate verification of his or her 22 identity. The agency shall provide explanations of the codes contained in the report if the agency released the person's 23 credit information to any entity doing business in this state 24 25 within the previous calendar year.
