Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development may 14 amend the boundaries of an area designated as an enterprise 15 16 zone in a community located wholly within the boundaries of a 17 consolidated government so long as the amendment does not increase the existing size of the enterprise zone by an area 18 19 of more than 2 square miles. The enterprise zone in said 20 community may also be expanded to include noncontiguous areas 21 designated as a federal empowerment zone under the 2000 22 Community Renewal Tax Relief Act without any limitations as to 23 size. 24 Section 2.
