startup costs for developing and establishing the plates have been recovered. 2. Up to 5 percent of the funds received by Sheridan House, Inc., shall be expended for administrative costs directly associated with the operations of Sheridan House, б Inc., and up to 20 percent of the funds received shall be expended for promotion and marketing of the license plate. 3. All remaining funds shall be expended by Sheridan House, Inc., to fund residential care programs, family counseling, social services for single parents and their children, resources materials, and facility construction. Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004.
