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which consists of a written portion and skills-demonstration portion approved by the board and administered at a site and by personnel approved by the department.

- (b) Has achieved a minimum score, established by rule of the board, on the nursing assistant competency examination, which consists of a written portion and skills-demonstration portion, approved by the board and administered at a site and by personnel approved by the department and:
 - 1. Has a high school diploma, or its equivalent; or
 - 2. Is at least 18 years of age.
- (c) Is currently certified in another state; is listed on that state's certified nursing assistant registry; and has not been found to have committed abuse, neglect, or exploitation in that state.
- (d) Has completed the curriculum developed under the Enterprise Florida Jobs and Education Partnership Grant and achieved a minimum score, established by rule of the board, on the nursing assistant competency examination, which consists of a written portion and skills-demonstration portion, approved by the board and administered at a site and by personnel approved by the department.
- (5) Certification as a nursing assistant, in accordance with this part, may be renewed continues in effect until such time as the nursing assistant allows a period of 24 consecutive months to pass during which period the nursing assistant fails to perform any nursing-related services for monetary compensation. When a nursing assistant fails to perform any nursing-related services for monetary compensation for a period of 24 consecutive months, the nursing assistant must complete a new training and competency evaluation program 31 or a new competency evaluation program.

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(7) A certified nursing assistant shall complete 12 18 1 hours of inservice training during each calendar year. The 3 certified nursing assistant shall be responsible for maintaining documentation demonstrating compliance with these 5 provisions. The Council on Certified Nursing Assistants, in accordance with s. 464.2085(2)(b), shall propose rules to 6 7 implement this subsection. (8) The department shall renew a certificate upon 8 receipt of the renewal application and imposition of a fee of 9 10 \$20 which may be increased to not more than \$50 biennially. 11 The department shall adopt rules establishing a procedure for the biennial renewal of certificates. Any certificate not 12 13 renewed by July 1, 2006, shall be void. (9) For purposes of this section, background screening 14 15 shall include: 16 (a) A determination whether the person seeking the certificate has committed any act that would constitute 17 grounds for disciplinary sanctions as provided in s. 18 19 464.204(1); and (b)1. For persons who have continuously resided in 20 this state for the 5 years immediately preceding the date of 2.1 screening, level 1 screening as set forth in chapter 435; or 2.2 2. For persons who have not continuously resided in 23 this state for the 5 years immediately preceding the date of 24 25 screening, level 2 screening as set forth in chapter 435. (10) Beginning January 1, 2005, the Department of 26 27 Health and the Agency for Health Care Administration shall, 28 after certification of an applicant, post information relating to background screening on the agency's background-screening database, which shall be available only to employers and 30 31 prospective employers, who, as a condition of employment, are
