A bill to be entitled
An act relating to educational facilities;
creating s. 1013.101, F.S.; allowing the use of
school board property as a public park under an
agreement between a school board and a local
government; absolving the school board from
liability for injuries resulting from such use;
providing restrictions on such use; providing
an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 1013.101, Florida Statutes, is
created to read:

1013.101 Joint use of school property for public park
purposes.--

(1) A school board may designate specific areas of
school board property that may be used as a public park
pursuant to an interlocal agreement with a municipal or county
government.

(2) The school board is not liable for injuries to any
individual or property which occur as a result of the use of
the property as a public park.

(3) The area designated for use as a public park may
not be used as a public park during school hours or when the
school is otherwise using the area for after-school
activities.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.

SENATE SUMMARY

Allows school boards to designate specific school board property to be used for public park purposes under an agreement between the school board and a local government. Absolves the school board from liability for injuries resulting from such use. Provides restrictions on such use.
