Subsections (4) and (6) of section 509.049, Florida Statutes, are amended to read: 20 21 509.049 Food service employee training.--22 (4) Approval of a program is subject to the provider's 23 continued compliance of the provider and its program with this section and the rules adopted under this section the 24 25 division's minimum program standards. The division may conduct 26 random audits of approved programs and providers to determine 27 compliance and may audit any program or provider if it has reason to believe a program or provider is not in compliance 28 29 with this section. The division may revoke a program's 30 approval if it finds a program or provider is not in

- (a) The use of application forms, which may require, but need not be limited to, the identification of training components of the program and an applicant affidavit attesting to the accuracy of the information provided in the application;
- (b) Providers to maintain records information concerning food service employees establishments where they have trained provide training pursuant to this section and establishments where their program is used to provide training to food service employees, and to submit such records to the division upon request;
- (c) Revocation of program approval if the provider has failed to maintain required records or has knowingly participated in falsifying any training record;
- $\underline{\text{(d)}}_{\text{(c)}}$ Specific subject matter related to food safety for use in training program components; and
- $\underline{\text{(e)}(d)}$ The licensee to be responsible for providing proof of employee training, and the division may request production of such proof upon inspection of the establishment.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

SENATE SUMMARY Provides that the approval of a food safety training program is subject to continued compliance of the private nonprofit provider and its program with the statutory provisions and rules relating to public food service establishments. Provides that the Division of Hotels and Restaurants of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation may conduct random audits of programs and providers. Provides that the division may adopt rules for providers to maintain records concerning food service employees and establishments. Provides that the division may adopt rules regarding revocation of program approval.
