20	(a) The department shall develop a Family First license
21	plate as provided in this section. The word "Florida" must
22	appear at the top of the plate, and the words "Family First"
23	must appear at the bottom of the plate.
24	(b) The annual use fees shall be distributed to Family
25	First to fund programs, projects, seminars, events, and family
26	resources that promote principles for building marriages,
27	guiding parents, and raising children. Family First shall retain
28	all revenues from the sale of the plate until its startup costs
29	for developing and establishing the plate have been recovered.
