Section 318.1216, Florida Statutes, is 15 16 created to read: 17 318.1216 Trauma center preparedness.--(1) This section may be known by the popular name the 18 19 "Trauma Center Preparedness Act." (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 318.121, a 20 21 board of county commissioners may require, by ordinance, that 22 the clerk of the court collect with each civil traffic penalty an additional amount of up to \$7, which shall be used to fund 23 state-approved trauma centers for unreimbursed costs. The 24 25 ordinance shall provide for the board of county commissioners to administer the funds. The funds must be used for the 26 27 unreimbursed costs incurred by state-approved trauma centers, 28 as defined in s. 395.4001, for providing trauma services. Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 29 30 law. 31
