However, except for violations of s. 316.613, 16 17 enforcement of this section by state or local law enforcement agencies must be accomplished only as a secondary action when 18 19 a driver of a motor vehicle has been detained for a suspected 20 violation of another section of this chapter, chapter 320, or 21 chapter 322. 22 Section 2.
