Any 24 25 confidential or exempt information provided to the Statewide Public Guardianship Office shall continue to be held 26 27 confidential or exempt as otherwise provided by law. All 28 records held by the Statewide Public Guardianship Office 29 relating to the medical, financial, or mental health of 30 vulnerable adults as defined in chapter 415, persons with a 31 developmental disability as defined in chapter 393, or persons 1

with a mental illness as defined in chapter 394, shall be confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995 in accordance with s. 119.15, and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2004, unless б reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature. Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2004. SENATE SUMMARY Revises the exemption from the public records law for certain records held by the Statewide Public Guardianship Office. Removes the repeal of the exemption scheduled on October 2, 2004, under the Open Government Sunset Review Act.
