An act relating to public K-12 education; amending s. 1003.05, F.S.; allowing children of military personnel transferred to Florida after a school year has begun to enroll in certain schools or programs in the state; providing that a student shall be enlisted for enrollment under certain circumstances; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (2) of section 1003.05, Florida
Statutes, is renumbered as subsection (3), and a new subsection
(2) is added to said section to read:

 1003.05 Assistance to transitioning students from military families.--

(2) Children of military personnel who receive military orders to transfer to this state after a school year has begun shall be allowed to enroll in a school or program included in the public school choice options, listed in s. 1002.20(6)(a); in

a public school that provides exceptional student education; or
in a public school exceptional student program if they were
enrolled in such a school or program in the state from which
they transferred. A school's enrollment deadline shall not
prevent such student from enrolling in a school or program
pursuant to this subsection. However, if such student is unable
to enroll in a school or program pursuant to this subsection due
to space limitation, such student shall be listed for enrollment
for the upcoming school term or school year.
Section 2 This act shall take effect July 1 2004
