- Nonballot, issue-advocacy advertisements by Section 1. organizations; reports.--
- (1) Any organization that raises money for purposes of making a nonballot, issue-advocacy advertisement after the close of qualifying for statewide candidates must file campaign finance disclosure reports that disclose the full name, address, and occupation, if any, of each person who has made one or more contributions to or for the organization within the reporting period, together with the amount and date of such contributions.
- (2) The disclosure reports required under subsection (1) must be filed with the Secretary of State, and the initial report must be filed at the end of the calendar quarter in which the organization first accepts a donation for such purposes. Subsequent reports must be filed on the schedule applicable to political candidates for office which is set forth in section 106.07, Florida Statutes.
  - Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2004.
