(1) The Anti-Fraud Trust Fund within the Office of Financial Regulation, FLAIR number 43-2-038, which 23 is to be terminated pursuant to Section 19(f), Article III of 24 25 the State Constitution on November 4, 2004, is re-created. (2) All current balances of the trust fund are carried 26 forward, and all current sources and uses of the trust fund 27 28 are continued. 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect November 4, 30 2004. 31
