I. Summary:

This bill re-creates the Resident Protection Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2004. The Resident Protection Trust Fund, FLAIR #68-2-522, is administered by the Agency for Health Care Administration. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 2000, by Chapter 2000-62, Laws of Florida.

This bill re-creates section 400.063, Florida Statutes.

II. Present Situation:

The fund tracks receipts and expenditures related to the alternate placement, care, and treatment of residents of certain licensed facilities when it is determines by the Agency for Health Care Administration that existing conditions or practices constitute an immediate danger to the health, safety, or security of the residents.
