This legislation re-creates the Library Services Trust Fund without modification, effective November 4, 2004. The Library Services Trust Fund, FLAIR #45-2-450, is administered by the Department of State. This fund was last re-created effective November 4, 2000, by Chapter 2000-92, Laws of Florida.
