This paragraph is subject to the Open Government Sunset 44 Review Act of 1995 in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand 45 46 repealed on October 2, 2010, unless reviewed and saved from 47 repeal through reenactment by the Legislature. 48 Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public 49 necessity that investigatory records held by the Commission for 50 Independent Education in conjunction with an investigation 51 conducted pursuant to section 1005.38(6), Florida Statutes, Page 2 of 3

52 including minutes and findings of an exempt probable cause panel meeting convened in conjunction with such investigation, be made 53 exempt from public records requirements for a period not to 54 55 exceed 10 days after a panel makes a determination regarding 56 probable cause. The Legislature further finds that it is a 57 public necessity that those portions of meetings of any probable cause panel convened in conjunction with such investigations at 58 59 which exempt investigatory records are discussed be made exempt 60 from public meetings requirements. The exemptions created by 61 this act relating to investigations conducted by the Commission 62 for Independent Education prevent unfounded complaints and 63 investigations from being used to damage the good name of an 64 institution or persons associated with the institution. Because 65 the information made exempt under this act will be available to 66 the public after a determination regarding probable cause is 67 made, public oversight will be maintained.

68 Section 3. This act shall take effect on the same date 69 that HB 1089 or similar legislation takes effect, if such 70 legislation is adopted in the same legislative session or an 71 extension thereof and becomes law.
