28 (1) The commission shall conduct its business within the 29 following guidelines:

(a) For purposes of hearing appeals under s. 121.23, the 30 31 commission may meet in panels consisting of not fewer than three 32 members. For the purpose of meeting in these panels, a quorum 33 shall be not fewer than two members. For all other purposes, a 34 quorum shall consist of three four members. The concurring vote 35 of a majority of the members present shall be required to reach 36 a decision, issue orders, and conduct the business of the 37 commission.
