Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 122, between lines 13 and 14,

insert:

Section 97. Short title.--This section may be cited as
the "Dori Slosberg Act of 2005."

Section 98. Subsections (4) and (8) of section
316.614, Florida Statutes, are amended, present subsection (9)
of that section is redesignated as subsection (10), and a new
subsection (9) is added to that section, to read:

316.614 Safety belt usage.--

(4) It is unlawful for any person:

(a) To operate a motor vehicle in this state unless
each passenger and the operator of the vehicle under the age
of 18 years is restrained by a safety belt or by a child
restraint device pursuant to s. 316.613, if applicable; or

(b) To operate a motor vehicle in this state unless
the person is restrained by a safety belt.
