This act shall take effect July 1, 2005. 9 10 SENATE SUMMARY 11 12 Prohibits a person who is convicted of a felony or misdemeanor and placed on probation or into community 13 control from becoming or remaining a criminal street gang member or associating with a person who is a criminal 14 street gang member, a criminal street gang associate, or a prison gang member. Requires a court to order intensive 15 supervision and surveillance for any offender placed on probation or into community control who is or was a criminal street gang member. Provides specified terms and 16 conditions for probation or community control. Authorizes a court to revoke probation if the offender fails to comply with the terms and conditions of probation. 17 18 Directs the Department of Corrections to notify certain sheriffs when an offender identified as a street gang 19 member is released from incarceration.
