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The Committee on Education Appropriations (Wise) recommended the following amendment:

Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 21, line 11, through page 24, line 7, delete those lines

and insert: with scholarship students to be of good moral character, to be subject to the level 1 background screening as provided under chapter 435, to be denied employment or terminated if required under s. 435.06, and not to be ineligible to teach in a public school because his or her educator certificate is suspended or revoked. For purposes of this paragraph:

1. An "individual with direct student contact" means any individual who has unsupervised access to a scholarship student for whom the private school is responsible.

2. The costs of fingerprinting and the background check shall not be borne by the state.

3. Continued employment of an individual after notification that the individual has failed the level 1

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1 background screening shall cause a private school to be
2 ineligible for participation in the John M. McKay Scholarships
3 for Students with Disabilities Program.

4 4. An individual holding a valid Florida teaching
5 certificate who has been fingerprinted pursuant to s. 1012.32
6 not required to comply with this paragraph.
