1 House Concurrent Resolution 2 A concurrent resolution ratifying the proposed amendment to 3 the Constitution of the United States relating to equal 4 rights for men and women. 5 6 WHEREAS, three years after women won the right to vote, the 7 Equal Rights Amendment to the United States Constitution, 8 authored by Alice Paul, head of the National Women's Party, was 9 introduced in Congress by Senator Curtis and Representative 10 Anthony, both Republicans, and WHEREAS, on March 22, 1972, the proposed amendment to the 11 United States Constitution was sent to the states for 12 ratification, and 13 WHEREAS, the Equal Rights Amendment to the United States 14 Constitution states: 15 16 "SECTION 1. Equality of rights under the law shall not be 17 denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on 18 account of sex. 19 "SECTION 2. The Congress shall have the power to enforce, by appropriate legislation, the provisions of this article. 20 21 "SECTION 3. This amendment shall take effect two years after the date of ratification.", and 22 WHEREAS, Congress placed a deadline of June 30, 1982, on 23 the ratification process and thirty-five states ratified the 24 25 proposed amendment before the deadline, and 26 WHEREAS, Congress may not have the constitutional authority 27 to place a deadline on the ratification process, and 28 WHEREAS, Article V of the United States Constitution allows

29 the Legislature of the State of Florida to ratify this proposed 30 amendment to the Constitution of the United States, and 31 WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Florida finds that 32 the proposed amendment is meaningful and needed as part of the United States Constitution and that the present political, 33 34 social, and economic conditions are the same or are even more 35 demanding as when the proposed amendment was first submitted for 36 adoption, NOW, THEREFORE, 37 38 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of Florida, the Senate Concurring: 39 40 That the proposed amendment to the Constitution of the 41 42 United States set forth below is ratified by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 43 44 "Article "SECTION 1. Equality of rights under the law shall not be 45 46 denied or abridged by the United States or by any State on 47 account of sex. 48 "SECTION 2. The Congress shall have the power to enforce, 49 by appropriate legislation, the provisions of this article. "SECTION 3. This amendment shall take effect two years 50 after the date of ratification." 51 52 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of the 53 foregoing preamble and resolution be immediately forwarded by 54 the Secretary of State of the State of Florida, under the great 55 seal, to the President of the United States, the Secretary of 56 State of the United States, the President of the Senate of the
