28	(a) The requirements of s. 636.204 are fulfilled.						
29	(b) The entity has the required minimum capital.						
30	(c) The ownership, control, and management of the						
31	entity are competent and trustworthy and possess managerial						
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experience that would make the proposed operation beneficial						
to the subscribers. If the office has good reason to believe						
that the ownership, control, or management of a discount						
medical plan organization includes a person whose business						
operations are or have been marked by business practices or						
conduct that is to the detriment of the public, stockholders,						
investors, or creditors, the office may not grant or continue						
the authority of such organization to transact the business of						
a discount medical plan organization in this state.						
(d) The discount medical plan organization has a						
complaint procedure that will facilitate the resolution of						
subscriber grievances and that includes, within the						
organization, formal and informal steps.						
(e) Any deficiencies identified by the office have						
been corrected.						
(f) All requirements of this part are met.						
(2) If the application for a license is denied, the						
office shall notify the applicant and shall specify the						
reasons for denial in the notice.
