15	403.814, Florida Statutes, to read:

17	(12) The department shall adopt rules authorizing a
18	general permit providing regulatory and proprietary
19	authorization to local governments for the construction and
20	maintenance of public marina facilities and public boat ramps.
21	Such facilities may preempt no more than 50,000 square feet of
22	sovereign submerged lands and shall be reviewed pursuant to
23	the regulatory criteria in s. 373.414. A public marina
24	facility constructed pursuant to this subsection must obtain
25	<u>Clean Marina Program status within a reasonable time after</u>
26	completion and must maintain such status for the life of the
27	facility. A facility approved pursuant to this subsection is
28	exempt from review as a development of regional impact if the
29	facility complies with the comprehensive plan of the
30	applicable local government. As used in this subsection, the
31	term "public" means the facility or ramp is open to the public

1 on a first-come, first-serve basis with a rental term not to 2 exceed 1 year. A facility or boat ramp constructed pursuant to 3 this subsection may not be sold to a private entity.
