Section 290.00698, Florida Statutes, is 13 amended to read: 290.00698 Enterprise zone designation for Okaloosa 14 County. --15 (1) Okaloosa County may apply to the Office of 16 17 Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development for designation of one enterprise zone within an area in Okaloosa County, which 18 zone encompasses an area up to 6 square miles. The 19 application must be submitted by December 31, 2001, and must 20 21 comply with the requirements of s. 290.0055, except subsection 22 (3) thereof. Notwithstanding the provisions of s. 290.0065 limiting the total number of enterprise zones designated and 23 the number of enterprise zones within a population category, 2.4 the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development may 25 designate one enterprise zone under this section. The Office 26 27 of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development shall establish the initial effective date of the enterprise zone designated 29 pursuant to this section. (2) The Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic 30 Development may, upon application by governing bodies of

1	Okaloosa County and the City of Crestview, amend the
2	boundaries of enterprise zone EZ-4601 in Okaloosa County. The
3	boundary amendment may not increase the size of the enterprise
4	zone by more than 5 square miles and the increased area must
5	have a contiquous boundary or be composed of not more than
6	three noncontiquous areas. The application must be submitted
7	by December 31, 2005.
8	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2005.
