26	other fines imposed, the court shall impose an additional \$500
27	fine for any person who violates s. 316.027(1).
28	(3) Notwithstanding s. 318.121 and in addition to any
29	other fines imposed, the court shall impose a \$500 surcharge
30	on any fine imposed pursuant to s. 316.192, s. 316.193, or s.
