On page 14, line 29, through
page 25, line 13, delete those lines

and insert:

1002.385 The Reading Compact Scholarships
Program.--There is established the Reading Compact
Scholarships Program, a program designed to offer students who
have not attained reading proficiency beyond Level 1 the tools
and assistance to further the students' progress in reading.

(1) PURPOSE.--The purpose of the Reading Compact
Scholarships Program is to provide to each student who has
scored at Level 1 on the reading portion of the FCAT a laptop
computer, training by the school for the parent and student on
how to use the laptop computer, and individualized reading
tutoring for the student.

(2) ELIGIBILITY.--A student who has scored at Level 1
on the reading portion of the FCAT may receive a Reading
Compact Scholarship for a period of 3 consecutive years.
