Proceedings of a dispute review board are open to the public, and notice must be given 2.4 to the local jurisdiction in which the contract work is 25 26 performed. The board shall review the contract and any documentation relating to the contract and may hear testimony 27 2.8 from any party to the contract or from the local jurisdiction in which the contract work is performed. If the parties do not 29 accept the recommendation of the board, the dispute shall 30 proceed to arbitration under s. 337.185. 31
