2 An act relating to the Homosassa Special Water District, Citrus County; providing for 3 annexation of specified areas; requiring a 4 5 referendum; providing an effective date. 6 7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 8 Section 1. Extension of district boundaries; Area A. --9 (1) The Homosassa Special Water District shall call 10 for a referendum no later than December 30, 2005, in 11 12 accordance with provisions of law relating to elections 13 currently in force. The purpose of said referendum shall be to determine whether the lands within Area A as described below 14 will be included within the territorial limits of the 15 district. Only those registered voters residing within Area A 16 and only those registered voters residing within the existing 18 territorial limits of the district may vote in said referendum. 19

17	Section 4. Sections 1, 2, and 3 of this act shall take
18	effect only upon their approval by a majority vote of those
19	qualified electors authorized under such sections and voting
20	in a referendum election to be called by the Homosassa Special
21	Water District to be held before December 30, 2005, in
22	accordance with the provisions of law relating to elections
23	currently in force, except that this section shall take effect
24	upon becoming a law.
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
