### **I. Amendments Contained in Message:**

**House Amendment 1 – 647497** (body with title)

### **II. Summary of Amendments Contained in Message:**

**House Amendment 1** keeps the provision in the Senate bill which provides for heightened evidence if the party against whom a protective injunction is sought is also a parent, stepparent, or legal guardian of the minor child.

This amendment does not, however, include the language in the Senate bill that grants a governmental employer standing to file an injunction petition on behalf of an employee who is the victim of repeat violence in a public workplace, which was adopted through amendment in the Senate Children and Families Committee.
