8-631-05 1 Senate Resolution No. A resolution recognizing March 15, 2005, as 2 "St. Johns County Day" in Tallahassee. 3 4 5 WHEREAS, on September 8, 1565, Don Pedro Menendez de 6 Aviles founded St. Augustine, the oldest continuously occupied 7 European settlement in the United States, and 8 WHEREAS, St. Johns County is the site for Fort Mose, established by Spaniards and former African slaves in 1738, 9 10 the first free black fort and settlement in North America, and WHEREAS, on July 21, 1821, St. Johns County, named for 11 12 the St. Johns River, became one of Florida's first two 13 counties by ordinance proclaimed by Major General Andrew Jackson, and 14 WHEREAS, St. Johns County encompasses 609 square miles, 15 from the many miles of beautiful beaches to the scenic Bartram 16 17 Trail Highway that runs along the St. Johns River, and WHEREAS, St. Johns County is a popular tourist 18 destination, hosting more than 2 million visitors each year to 19 the historic City of St. Augustine, to St. Augustine Beach, 20 21 and to other communities throughout the county, and 22 WHEREAS, St. Johns County is one of the nation's most 23 recognized golf destinations and is home to the World Golf Hall of Fame and to THE PLAYERS CHAMPIONSHIP, which is an 2.4 internationally recognized golf event, and is also the 25 national headquarters for the PGA Tour, and 26 27 WHEREAS, St. Johns County is also home to the 2.8 Association of Tennis Players Tour, headquartered in Ponte 29 Vedra Beach, and 30 WHEREAS, agriculture is a critical component of the economy of St. Johns County, with its 149 farms on 49,631 31 1
