25	CATEGORY FIVE and shall be awarded by competitive solicitation

********* SENATE SUMMARY Requires the Department of Corrections to treat a revenue-producing contract in which a vendor is authorized to use state authority or property to sell any good or service as the procurement of a contractual service in excess of \$250,000 and to award the contract by competitive solicitation in the same manner as procurement of means of transport under part II of chapter 287, Florida Statutes.
