Any person who 26 27 violates the provisions of this section by selling or offering 2.8 for sale an alcohol-vaporizing device after having been previously convicted of such an offense within the past 5 29 years commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as 30 provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. 31
