NASCAR 2.4 license plates must bear the colors and design approved by the 25 department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the 26 27 plate, and the term "NASCAR" must appear at the bottom of the 2.8 plate. The NASCAR Hall of Fame, after consultation with the National Association for Stock Car Auto Racing, Inc., and the 29 International Speedway Corporation, may submit a sample plate 30 for consideration by the department. 31
