52	Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public
53	necessity that the agency report submitted under s. 21.006,
54	Florida Statutes, and the records, including working papers and
55	drafts, prepared or maintained by the Legislative Sunset
56	Advisory Committee in presenting the report required under s.
57	21.009, Florida Statutes, be made exempt from public records
58	requirements. The Legislature finds that the release of the
59	information would hinder the ability of the committee to conduct
60	its evaluation and prepare its report on whether to abolish a
61	state agency and its advisory committees because the agency,
62	employees, and other interested persons might be reluctant to
63	provide information knowing that the information would
64	immediately be public and could potentially affect the
65	operation, employment, or other dealings at the agency under
66	review. Protecting the information would help the committee
67	complete a more thorough and reliable evaluation and, therefore,
68	make a better recommendation as to whether or not to terminate a
