4	The CS amends ss. 562.11(1)(a)2., F.S., and 322.057, F.S., to provide that these provisions do not apply to a licensee who
5	violates subparagraph 1. while acting within the scope of his or her license or an employee or agent of a licensee who
6 7	violates subparagraph 1. while engaged within the scope of his or her employment or agency.
8	The CS amends s. 322.057, F.S., to delete the provision that limits the application of the penalties to persons who are 21
9	years of age or older. It also adds the conjunction "or" to correct a technical deficiency due to the omission of that conjunction.
10	The CS changes the effective date to October 1, 2006.
