I of the State Constitution if the disclosure of the 8 information would reveal information specific to a particular 9 policy or policyholder. However, This exemption does not 10 prevent the disclosure of any information by the Florida 11 12 Surplus Lines Service Office may, in furtherance of its duties 13 and responsibilities, disclose such information to the department, but the exemption applies to records obtained by 14 the department from the Florida Surplus Lines Service Office. 15 16 The exemption does not apply to any proceeding instituted by 17 the department or office against an agent or insurer.
