The owner of a fire hydrant is responsible for performing the required 2.4 testing, inspecting, or maintenance of that fire hydrant. 25 (b) Inspection results that determine that a private 26 27 fire hydrant is nonfunctioning must be reported immediately to 2.8 the local authorities having jurisdiction. (c) The owner of a private fire hydrant shall cause 29 30 any repair or replacement indicated by an inspection to be 31

(e) Penalties for noncompliance with this subsection shall be in accordance with s. 633.171. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2006. ***** SENATE SUMMARY Requires owners of fire hydrants to test hydrants in accordance with national standards.
