(e) Participating charitable organizations that 25 26 provide direct services in a local fiscal agent's area shall 27 receive the same percentage of undesignated funds as the 2.8 percentage of designated funds they receive. The undesignated funds remaining following allocation to these community-based 29 charitable organizations shall be distributed by the local 30 31 steering committee.
