A 19 warning letter shall be mailed to the sponsoring organization 20 21 following the first month in which the total number of valid 22 specialty plate registrations is below 1,000 plates. 23 (b) The department is authorized to discontinue the issuance of a specialty license plate and distribution of 24 associated annual use fee proceeds if the organization no 25 longer exists, if the organization has stopped providing 26 27 services that are authorized to be funded from the annual use 28 fee proceeds, or pursuant to an organizational recipient's 29 request.
